HISTORY Three generations of Gaineys have shaped the ranch into a thriving

Later, they were the first to have vineyard holdings in both Santa Ynez Valley and the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. Dan Gainey, along with a few others, was influential in developing the Santa Rita

Hills appellation.

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
